



EFYC FRIDAY AFTERNOON JAM SAILING

ADDENDUM TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - EFFECTIVE FROM 3 OCTOBER 2011 Rev. 8

To be read in conjunction with the clubs standard sailing instructions and appendix.

1. PREAMBLE

Friday afternoon sailing is a social event to encourage the members to visit the Club during the week and to use their yachts. The sailing will be informal and the results will not be entered into the race computer and therefore the normal handicaps will not be affected. Taking part will not count towards the participation score. There will be no support vessel, so participants should monitor VHF Ch 77 and assist any boats, which may require assistance. Major incidents should be reported to the Club on 9339 8111 or on Ch 16, which is constantly monitored by the Authorities.

2. RULES

Sailing will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing of the Australian Yachting Federation, and the current EFYC Sailing Instructions, except as any of these are changed by these sailing instructions.

3. ENTRIES

All competitors shall nominate on the appropriate form located in the Wet Bar. Late nominations will be accepted.

4. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACE

- 5.1 All divisions will start together.
- 5.2 Start times are **1545 hrs** during the summer season and at **1400 hrs** during winter.
- 5.3 Division 1 & 2 yachts will complete Course 1 and Division 3 & 4 yachts will complete Course 2.
- 5.4 Division 1 & 2 yachts may do the shorter course if they are only using one sail.
- 5.5 Spinnakers are not permitted in any division.

6. COURSE

All Starts will be in a South-westerly direction. Shortened courses will be made prior to the race commencement by notice being placed in the wet bar.

7. SIGNING OFF

As there will not be anyone monitoring the Start/Finish line competitors will be required to sign off by including the time they cross the finish line. The Winner will be the first boat over the line, or as determined by the PRO.

8. SAFETY

All boats must comply with Category 7 and must monitor VHF Ch 77. In an emergency the Club's phone number is 9339 8111. Major incidents should be reported on Ch 16, which is constantly monitored by the Authorities. Sailing will be cancelled if the wind speed is predicted to be over 25 knots.
