



EFYC SHORT RACE COURSES

ADDENDUM TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

EFFECTIVE FROM MAY 2010

To be read in conjunction with the clubs standard sailing instructions and appendix.

1. **RULES**

Races will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions and safety regulations of the Australian Yachting Federation, the rules of the classes or associations sailed, the current EFYC Sailing Instructions, except as any of these are changed by these sailing instructions.

1.1 ***Special Regulations***

Keelboat races are classified as category 7.

2. **ENTRIES**

All competitors shall nominate on the appropriate form. Nomination forms are located on the keelboat notice board in the Wet Bar. Nominations will close twenty minutes prior to the scheduled start time for each race. Late nominations may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee. Nominations will not be accepted for any boat after its division Preparatory signal. Boats sailing with other than their complying sail number must obtain written approval from the Race Committee prior to each race.

3. **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in the Wet Bar.

4. **SCHEDULE OF RACES**

For Short Course Series events, the warning signal for the first race will be approximately 5 minutes prior to 13:00 Hrs (at the discretion of the starters). Divisions or classes may be combined and start together. The start time of races may be altered in accordance with instruction 4 of the Sailing Instructions 2008/2009, at the sole discretion of the Race Committee. Minor re-scheduling may also be made on the day of racing by communicating the information to each boat before her warning signal. Such information may be given orally to boats already on the water.

4.1 ***Shortened Course Races – Start Schedule***

On race days scheduled for shortened course races, the preparatory signal for the start sequence of the second and subsequent races will be approximately 5 minutes after the completion of the last boat from the previous race or 5 minutes after the expiry of the race time limit, whichever is the earlier.

5. **TIME LIMITS**

Shortened Courses

The time limit shall be one hour from the start for each class or division this changes rule 35. Boats failing to finish within the time limit, or within 15 minutes of the first boat in their class or division finishing, which ever is the later will be scored DNF.

6. **WIND STRENGTH**

Races may be cancelled if winds are, or are forecast above 25 knots.
