Supplementary Sailing Instructions

*14th November, 12th December 2008
9th January, 13th February and 13th March 2009*

1. RULES

These sailing instructions are to be read in conjunction with the clubs standard sailing instructions and appendix.

2. START

	Jam	Div 3 & 4	Div 1 & 2
Warning	1825	1830	1835
Start	1830	1835	1840

3. COURSE – Westerly wind direction

- a) Jam
Cross the start line in a westerly direction
Mt Lyall (9) to starboard
Miller Buoy (28) to Port
Outer Dolphin spit (17) to Port
Finish.
- b) Division 3 & 4
Cross the start line a westerly direction
Mt Lyall buoy (9) to starboard
Scotch Spit (57) to starboard
Burnside Spit (58) to starboard
College Buoy (23) to starboard
Miller Buoy (28) to Port
Outer Dolphin Spit (17) to Port
Finish

- c) Division 1 & 2
Cross the start line in a westerly direction
Lyll Buoy (9) to starboard
Scotch Spit (57) to starboard
Burnside Spit (58) to starboard
College Buoy (23) to starboard
Miller Buoy (28) to Port
Outer Dolphin Spit (17) to Port
Middle Spit (55) to starboard
Scotch Spit (57) to starboard
Burnside Spit (58) to starboard
College buoy (23) to starboard
Finish

Easterly wind direction

All fleets start in an easterly direction and delete Lyll Buoy (9) from the courses as detailed above.

4. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

All boats shall comply with category 5 of the AYF Special Safety Regulations. Each boat must carry at least one hand held light. The Race Committee has the right to disqualify boats not showing the appropriate lights.

5. FINISHING

Boats must illuminate sail numbers as they finish to aid the finishing crew.

6. RETIRING

All retiring skippers should inform the EFYC Support boat or the Start/Finish Tower as soon as possible on 9339 2208.

7. NOMINATIONS

Skippers are required to nominate on the notice board in the Wet Bar. Nominations to include skipper and boat details, number of crew and a mobile phone number that will be operational during the event.

Nomination for this event is confirmation by the owner or owner's representative that he or she has read and understands the AYF Special Regulations applicable to Category 5 as detailed in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005 – 2008.
