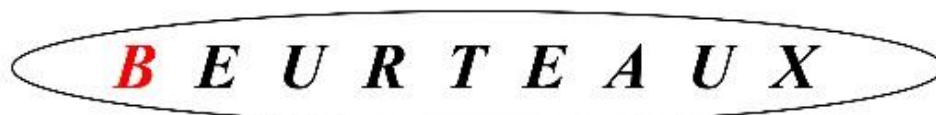

1. RULES

- 1.1 The organising authority is East Fremantle Yacht Club (Inc.) in conjunction with the Australian Sports Boats Association of Western Australia (ASBA).
- 1.2 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions and special regulations of Australia Sailing, Navigable Waters Regulations and the Class Rules of the Australian Sports Boat Association (ASBA).

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising on a boat shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20 (ISAF Advertising Code). The Organising Authority may decline to accept an application for entry of a boat which, in its opinion, is carrying advertising which conflicts with governmental regulations. In any case of doubt, the Organising Authority should be consulted as soon as practicable.
- 2.2 An application for entry shall contain brief details of all advertising that a boat intends to carry. The Organising Authority shall be advised of any changes to that advertising.
- 2.3 The EFYC Race Committee shall be sole judge as to whether advertising is in good taste and does not conflict with the interests of race sponsors.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 By invitation only. Eligible boats, as per 3.2, may request an invitation by completing the attached nomination form and by e-mailing it to activities@efyc.com.au or posting it to:

Nomination forms must be received no later than **5:00pm Monday 10th January 2022**.
- 3.2 The regatta is open to all Sports Boats as defined by the Australian Sports Boat Association, with a SMS rating above 0.755. Boats must comply with the Rules and the provisions of Category 7.

4. FEES

An entry fee of \$40 per boat will apply.

5. PRE-RACE BRIEFING

A mandatory pre-race briefing for Skippers, or their representative, will be held in the “Observation Lounge” at the East Fremantle Yacht Club on Friday 14 January 2022 at 1800 hrs. A skipper who is unable to attend may apply in writing to be represented by a member of his crew. Hospitality will be provided between 6 and 7pm for All Skippers.

6. SCHEDULE

The regatta will consist of up to 3 races. All races will be handicap starts. The warning signal for the first race is scheduled for 1355 hrs.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on Friday 14th January 2022 at the mandatory briefing.

8. VENUE AND COURSES

Racing will be conducted on the Swan River directly in front of the EFYC Clubhouse.

9. SCORING

The overall winner will be determined by the boat with the lowest aggregate score.

10. SPONSORS, PRIZES AND RESULTS

This event is sponsored by.

10.1 Beurteaux Marine Interior, Lightfoot Property, Fuel Distributors of Western Australia, and Gage Roads

10.2 Cash Prizes and results will be announced and presented at the EFYC Clubhouse at 1700hrs.

10.3 A perpetual trophy and Cash prize will be awarded to the Winner of the Regatta.

10.4 Prizes will also be awarded to 2nd and 3rd Place.

10.5 Competitors who finish in 1st, 2nd and 3rd place, in all three races, will be awarded EFYC pennants.

10.6 Hospitality will be provided for Sailors after racing.

10.7 There will also be a Prize for the biggest Wipeout as decided by the commentators.

10.8 There will also be pre-booked Hospitality Packages available for spectators on the Observation deck during the Sports boats racing.

11. SUPPORT / ON-WATER PROTEST BOATS

Support / On-Water Protest boats will be marked with a Safety Flag. All protests will be handled by the Protest Chairman on the water with the Protest Committee's decision being final.

12. ON WATER PROTESTS AND PROTEST TIME LIMIT

12.1 Protests shall be lodged with the Race Officer (RO) verbally as soon as practicable after the protesting boat finishes the race in which the incident occurred (amends RRS 61.2 and 61.3).

12.2 Protests may be heard on the water between races at the discretion of the RO and Protest Committee (PC).

12.3 On water observers appointed by the RO may give evidence at a protest hearing and may be members of the PC.

13. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS Rule 44.1 and 44.2 is amended so that a one turn penalty is required.

14. BERTHING

Competitors are invited to berth their boats in EFYC pens from the evening of Friday 14th January 2022 until noon on Saturday 15th January 2022. Alternately boats and trailers can be parked on the lawn area inside the EFYC grounds. Please advise your preferred option when submitting your nomination form.

Yachts must keep clear of the racing area from 10:00am until the completion of last Centerboard race.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1 All those taking part in the A Rumble in the Reach: Sports Boat Challenge, conducted by the East Fremantle Yacht Club do so at their own risk.

15.2 The East Fremantle Yacht Club, any sponsor and any other party involved in the organisation of the event disclaims any and every responsibility for any loss, damage injury to persons and things, both ashore and on the water, as a consequence of participation in any way in the races covered by this Notice of Race.

15.3 Attention is drawn to RRS Rule 4 which states that "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone."

16. WARNING

Sailing and activities associated with it involve risks of a personal injury, loss and damage and even death. The risks include but are not limited to, the risk of injury from collision, capsizing, falling overboard, being trapped under the sail or boat after it capsizes and impact with equipment. Any of these events can also result in death.

The risks involved in this activity are heightened by;

- Adverse weather conditions
- Inadequate training
- Fatigue
- Inexperience
- Use of alcohol or any other drug that may affect judgement or response time
- Failure to maintain the boat
- Failure to supply and use the recommended safety equipment
- Failure to observe the RRS and YAI Prescriptions and Special Regulations and the 2022 Rumble in the Reach: Sports Boat Challenge Sailing Instructions.

This warning is given as a risk warning pursuant to Section 51 of the Civil Liability Act 2002 (as amended). Having given this risk warning, East Fremantle Yacht Club will not be held liable for any personal injury or death, however it may occur.

17. INSURANCE

Each participating boat will have current valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million for any one incident.
